# Method Diagrams on the Chiltern Branch Website

- Work started in 2017 to provide learners with a ready source of method diagrams.
- A selection of methods, calls and variations are available

### Method diagrams

- User interface to select number of bells, method and variation (where available)
- Displays a plain course of the method
- Select one or more 'blue lines' for that method to show bell interactions
- Select calls (Bob or Single) where available to show the effect on the method
- Splice another method at the required change
- Repeated row report useful during touch construction or splicing
- Copy the URL of the constructed diagram for future reference
- Re-open the saved URL to reproduce the diagram.

### Touches

• A selection of touches of common methods

### **Doubles Variation Cross Reference**

- An alternative to selecting variations from the method diagram
- Order by base method name or variation name

### **Method Tutor**

- Select number of bells, method and variation (where available)
- Select a practice bell
- Select one or more 'blue lines' for that method to show bell interactions
- In, out or stay in place via keyboard or 'buttons' below the method diagram.
- Select calls (Bob or Single) where available to practise action following call
- Splice another method at the required change to practise action following change

## **Construction Tools**

### Create Blue Line

- Select number of bells, hunt bells, treble action (Plain hunt / Treble bob hunt) and method name
- Trace the method from any other bell

### **Create Method**

- Select number of bells and method name
- Define place bells for each row in a lead

### Show or Create a Bob / Single

• Define track for each bell above the treble

### The Future ?

• Add more methods maybe from the CCCBR Method Library
